## **Caring for Your Etna Collection Products**

**Seasonal Living Etna Collection** products are handcrafted from volcanic stone, ceramic glazes, and steel bases. Natural volcanic activity creates volcanic stone, which is harvested from quarries and cut to size. Volcanic stone is extremely strong and resilient for everyday use. Once the stone is cut, artisans hand-apply ceramic glazes to tabletops, floor, or wall claddings. Etna Collection furniture items typically include a powder-coated steel base. Each item is a unique piece of art, and no two pieces are alike. Etna Collection pieces can be used for residential or commercial applications.

### **Features**

- As handcrafted products, each piece is unique. No two will be alike.
- Ceramic finishes will vary depending on specific glaze mix and artisans' individual handcrafting techniques.
- A ceramic surface might include small light or dark spots, appearances of cracks in the glaze, color variations, color flecks, or tiny surface pits. They should not be considered defects.
- Glazes do not contain substances that are toxic or poisonous to humans or the environment.

### **Care**

- Regularly rinse or wipe off dust, dirt, or debris to keep pieces clean.
- Rinse or wash gently by hand using clean water and a soft, nonabrasive cloth. You can use a small amount of dishwashing soap before rinsing thoroughly and allowing to dry.
- Never use pressure washers or spray devices, which can damage glaze surfaces.
- Do not clean with bleach, alcohol, ammonia-based products, abrasive cleaners, baking soda, chemicals, or devices that can cause the ceramic glaze to discolor or weaken.

## Caring for Your Etna Collection Products

- Do not place hot items, such as pots, pans, plates, or dishes on surface without a placemat, trivet, or protective heat-resistant barrier.
- Do not use any surface as a chopping or cutting board.
- Do not drop objects onto furniture or allow impact.
- Do not climb, stand, or jump on or off furniture. Do not sit on tables, chair arms, or seat backs. Chairs and stools are designed for seating only one person at any time. Never use furniture as a stepladder. Only use pieces as they are described for use in Seasonal Living descriptions.
- Strictly follow all manufacturer's product use instructions, care guidelines, product warnings, and other instructions supplied with the product.

### We Recommend

- Use high-quality, breathable furniture covers to protect pieces when not in use.
- Protect furniture from sub-zero temperatures with professional-grade furniture covers.
- Never allow water or other liquid to remain in—or on top of—any ceramic product. Moisture expanding from freezing temperatures can cause ceramic pieces to crack or break.

### Moving and Installation

- Etna Collection pieces are extremely heavy. Be sure to have adequate manpower and/or machinery to uncrate, assemble, and move tabletops or furniture into place.
- Read all assembly instructions first to ensure that you have the correct tools and all required parts.
- Always remove stone tops and protect them before moving furniture. Replace tops after furniture base is in place.
- Keep furniture level at all times.
- Never drag a product across a floor or surface.
- If you are unsure about installing any Etna Collection piece, consult a professional. Always install wall, counter, bar tops, floor, and other coverings using a professional stone installer.
- Never allow children to assist in uncrating, installing, or moving furniture. Do not allow them to play around installed pieces, stored furniture, or packaging.

### Care of Metal Bases

- Avoid scrapes, scratches, or impact to powder-coated steel surfaces. If the powder coating is damaged, the metal can begin to rust or corrode.
- Clean bases with dish soap and clean water and a soft cloth. Rinse and let dry.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or brushes on any part of the base.
