## **Caring for Your Provenance Signature Collection FRP Products**

Embracing the healing elements of nature, the **Provenance Signature Collection** offers a selection of material palettes curated to emphasize the concept of wellness. Provenance Signature Collection pieces are crafted from Fiber Reinforced Polymer (FRP), which can be recycled at the end of its life. A proprietary blend of glass, fiberglass polymer, and polymer fiber, FRP produces strong, yet lightweight, furniture. Provenance Signature Collection pieces crafted from FRP offer outstanding indoor and outdoor performance with almost zero care requirements.

### **Features**

- FRP pieces are supported by internal powder-coated steel skeletons.
- Pieces feature ultra-realistic finishes and are sealed for protection against weather.
- Provenance Signature Collection furniture is designed for full outdoor and indoor use.

### **Care of FRP Pieces**

- Wipe FRP furniture after each use to remove any standing water on the surface.
- Use hot pads or coasters to protect against heat, such as that from hot pots or pans, candle wax, or hot liquids, which can damage the sealant and finish.
- Avoid contact with acidic fruits, condiments, juices, alcohol, tea, soda, and other beverages. Clean up spills immediately to avoid damaging the sealant.
- Do not use FRP product surfaces for cutting or scoring. Avoid scraping, nicking, or gouging surface with forks, knives, or other sharp utensils or dropping heavy objects on the surface.
- Clean FRP products regularly with a soft foam pad, non-dyed dish soap, and warm water. Rinse well and allow to dry naturally.

## Caring for Your Provenance Signature Collection FRP Products

- Do not use sprays, abrasive cleaners, bleach, ammonia, alcohol, or baking soda on any FRP surface. Do not use products made for use on wood, tile, or windows. Professional-Grade Contract Electrostatic Sprays can be used on FRP surfaces if they are formulated specifically for Contract/Hospitality cleaning and not undiluted pure chemicals.
- If a surface becomes chipped, use the Seasonal Living FRP Repair Kit. The Kit includes a video providing repair instructions. Watch the video and follow all instructions.
- Use high-quality, breathable, ventilated furniture covers to protect furniture when not in use.
- Only use furniture on level surfaces and do not rock back and forth on any type of seating.
- Do not climb, stand, or jump on or off furniture. Do not sit on tables, chair arms, or seat backs. Chairs and stools are designed for seating only one person at any time. Never use furniture as a stepladder.
- Do not overload furniture with weight exceeding 250 Lbs/113.4 Kgs.
- Failure to use the product in the way it is described can lead to damaged or broken FRP products, severe bodily injury, and possibly death. Do not allow children to play on or underneath any furniture at any time.
- Do not lift pieces of furniture alone. Always get adult assistance to unpack, assemble, set up, and move any piece of furniture.
- Always follow all assembly and safe handling instructions to move and install tables. Remove tabletops before moving table base and re-installing.
- Protect furniture from extreme weather.

### We Recommend

- Regularly inspect all furniture for damage.
- Never drag furniture across a floor or surface.
- Move furniture under cover during winter, if possible.
- If this is not possible, cover furniture with a professional-grade furniture covers.
- If a table base comes into contact with ice and snow, we recommend raising the base a few inches off the ground.
